The Demarest Office of Emergency Management (OEM) in conjunction with the governing body, first responders and borough officials have been working to prepare for this challenge. Demarest OEM has trained for such a health emergency. Our first responders are ready.

There are no confirmed cases of COVID 19 in the borough of Demarest. OEM and borough officials have been in communication with Bergen County officials in order to receive the latest information about this health emergency.

Many of you are aware that public schools are closed countywide because of the COVID 19 virus. As of noon today, the Demarest Municipal Library will also close until March 30.

Borough Hall employees will be on the job during this emergency. However, the building will be closed to the public. Anyone needing services at the borough hall starting Monday, March 16, can visit the borough website, demarestnj.org, or call the borough at (201) 768-0167 and follow the prompts.

Anyone needing to make a payment can use the drop box outside the borough hall. Anyone needing in-person assistance at borough hall, please use the police phone located at the bottom of the stairs.

During this emergency, updates from the borough will be available through the borough website, the electronic message board at the corner of County Road and Hardenburgh Ave. and through NIXLE.com.

This health emergency will be challenging, but the OEM, first responders and the governing body stand ready to keep our residents informed.
